Quilt Top Assembly

For Throw size quilt:

Assemble the quilt top using the following Blocks (each 12 ½" x 12 ½" unfinished):



(1) Block 1



(4) Block 2



(4) Block 3



(4) Block 4




(8) Block 5



(4) Block 6

Arrange the blocks as shown below, rotating the blocks to match the following diagram. Sew blocks into rows then sew rows together, pressing all seams open. The quilt top should measure 60 ½" x 60 ½".

For Twin size quilt:

Assemble the quilt top using the following Blocks (each 12 ½" x 12 ½" unfinished):



(1) Block 1




(4) Block 7

Arrange the blocks as shown below, rotating the blocks to match the following diagram. Sew blocks into rows then sew rows together, pressing all seams open. The quilt top should measure 60 ½" x 84 ½".

Assemble the quilt top using the following Blocks (each 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished):






(8) Block 5
